

Support Next Generation of Recreational Boat Engines

Pass the FAST Act

Lawmakers in Washington, D.C. are on the verge of advancing legislation to significantly curb greenhouse gas emissions and the recreational boating industry stands ready to help policymakers achieve this objective. The National Marine Manufacturers Association is calling on boat businesses of all sizes to **support the Fueling America's Security and Transportation with Electricity Act of 2021 (FAST Electricity Act)**, which incentivizes the development and use of zero emission transportation options, including recreational boats.

What does the FAST Act do?

- **Provides a 30% personal and business federal tax credit for purchasing a recreational boat powered by a renewable fuel source.**
- **Establishes a 30% federal tax credit for building electric and hydrogen fueling stations.**
- **Expands the Advanced Technology Vehicles Manufacturing (ATVM) loan program to support American manufacturing of zero emission recreational boats and the corresponding supply chains needed to produce them.**
